



Ski-Doo Donates Over \$105,000 Value to OFSC Clubs *BRP Contribution Helps Volunteers Improve Snowmobile Trails*

(Barrie, ON. March 6, 2009): Snowmobile clubs across Ontario are recipients of over \$105,000 in value from the Ski-Doo Million Dollar Club Support Program.
